

Goats Dept. 25

1. The Junior Market Goat show is restricted to junior exhibitors. Young bucks only, age 9 months and younger. Young bucks will show in the buck show only.
2. Exhibitors will be limited to two entries per class in all breeding classes.
3. Exhibitors may have a maximum of three in the market goat classes.
4. Goats must be owned by the exhibitors by July 15, of this year.
5. All registered goats must have a legible tattoo, as recorded on registration certificate. All goats must have a Scrapie identification ear tag.
6. Animals must be owned and registered in the exhibitor's name. No pending registrations will be accepted. Open exhibitors may show registered breeding animals only and pay a separate entry fee.
7. Does and wethers will show but does shown in the dairy goat show may not show in the market goat show.
8. The minimum weight is 30 pounds with no maximum weight.
9. Market goats must have baby teeth.
10. Any breed of goat or cross (unless shown in dairy show, see #6 above) may show in the market show but a separate entry is required.
11. Goats may have horns but horns must be tipped for safety.
12. Animals must be weighed on official scales and weight recorded by the superintendent or someone designated by the superintendent.
13. All entries may be tested for drugs.
14. If an exhibitor's animal is less than minimum weight, the animal will be shown in a prospect class. Prospect classes will not be sale eligible for auction. If an animal is over weight, they will not be eligible to show. If there is no eligible entry for a species, that sale spot will be forfeited.

Division 101 Breeding Meat Goats (Age based on the date of show.)

- 01 Kids 0 - 3 months
- 02 Kids 3 - 6 months
- 03 Kids 6 - 9 months
- 04 Kids 9 – 12 months
- 05 Yearlings 12 - 16 months
- 06 Yearlings 16 - 20 months
- 07 Yearlings 20 – 24 months
- 08 Senior 24 to 36 months
- 09 Senior 36 months and over
- 14 Aged Doe

Division 102 – Dairy Goats - Jr. Doe Division (Does under 24 months that have never freshened)

- 01 Junior kid (4/10/ this year and later)
- 02 Intermediate kid (3/11/this year to 4/9/this year)

03 Senior kid (2/24/this year to 3/10/this year)
04 Winter Kid (1/1/this year to 2/23/this year)
05 Junior Yearling (4/20/last year to 12/31/last year)
06 Senior Yearling (10/19/two years previous to 4/18/previous year)
07 Senior Doe division (any doe that has ever freshened or being milked regularly)
Does under 2 years of September 1, this year
08 Does 2 years as of September 1, this year
09 Does 3 years as of September 1, this year
10 Does 4 years as of September 1, this year
11 Does 5 years of older as of September 1, this year

Division 103 – Young Bucks (Less than 1 year old)

01 Young Bucks 0 - under 3 months
02 Young Bucks 3 - under 6 months
03 Young Bucks 6 - under 9 months

Division 104 Goat Showmanship (Age as of show day)

Wee Jr. Goat Showmanship (Ages 8 and under)
Junior Goat Showmanship (Ages 9-13)
Senior Goat Showmanship (Ages 14-19)

Division 105 Wether Dam

101: Wether Dam class to be determined after checkin
102: Hair Doe

DIVISION 112 Bred and Owned Goat

Must be registered in the Exhibitor's name and commercial entries must be verified by and FFA teacher or extension personnel. (Commercial entries allowed for 2026 Fair only)
