

ORDINANCE 2025- 07

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CLEBURNE, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2024-45 TO EXPEND REMAINING ARPA FUNDS ON THE BOOKS OF THE COUNTY.

Section 1. This court affirms the requirement of the U.S. Treasury to either expend remaining American Rescue Plan Act funds by December 31, 2024 or obligate any remaining ARPA funds on the books of the county by December 31, 2024 for expenditure on or before December 31, 2026.

Section 2. The following is Cleburne County’s expenditure plan of American Rescue Plan Act funds in the amount of \$64,914.62 to be expended on or before December 31, 2024, as an appropriated transfer from the ARPA Revenue Replacement Fund to the County General Fund for payment of certain personnel costs of 2024 as an allowed expense of general government services under the ARPA Final Rule issued by the U.S. Treasury which became effective April 1, 2022.

Said American Rescue Plan Act dollars received through the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund are hereby used for the following expenditures:

Reimbursement of 2024 Personnel Costs for the following County General Office:

Section 3. Appropriated Transfer Action. The above action constitutes an appropriated transfer by this court. The transfer of funds for certain personnel costs will be made by the Cleburne County Treasurer upon Order of the County Court to transfer \$64,914.62 from the ARPA Revenue Replacement Fund 1006 to County General 1000.

Section 4. Effective Date. The U.S. Treasury has mandated that any unspent ARPA funds held by this county must be obligated or spent no later than December 31, 2024 and in order to facilitate that mandate without error this appropriation ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by the Quorum Court and approval by the County Judge pursuant to § 14-14-907(f).
