Vendors must include a current copy of their liability insurance with this completed application. Liability insurance must be current at time of fair. Vendors are responsible for collecting and remitting sales tax.

Release of Liability

The undersigned vendor agrees to assume all responsibility for the operation of their concession trailer/booth/tent during the Cleburne County Fair. The vendor releases and holds harmless the Cleburne County Fair Board, its officers, members, volunteers and agents from any and all claims, damages, losses, injuries or liabilities arising from the vendor's participation in the fair, including the operation of equipment, food service activities, and use of fairgrounds.

Compliance with Laws and Health Regulations

By signing this application, the vendor agrees to comply with all federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations. This includes, but is not limited to, all health, safety, and sanitation rules enforced by the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH). The Vendor is solely responsible for obtaining and maintaining all necessary licenses, permits, and food handler certifications required to legally operate their concession at the Event. The Vendor agrees to allow health department inspections of their booth at any time and assumes full liability for any fines, penalties, or closures resulting from non-compliance.
