The Clerk’s office is located at 301 W. Main St, Heber Springs, AR 72543. An objection must be filed with the Cleburne County Clerk in writing prior to the following deadlines. An objection that an official is a spouse of a county election commissioner, a county party chair or a spouse of a county party chair must be filed within 7 days of March 11<sup>th</sup>. An objection that an official is married to a candidate or related to a candidate within two degrees of blood relations must be filed within 10 days of March 11<sup>th</sup>.
