May 14, 2020

The Cleburne County Quorum Court met in regular session in the County Court Building, 922 South 9th Street, Heber Springs, Arkansas. The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. County Judge Jerry Holmes presided. PRESENT: Pearson, Henegar, Caldwell, Blackburn, Malone, Evans, Foust, Grace, Roberts, Owens. ABSENT: Gracey.

READING, CORRECTION, AND DISPOSITION OF MINUTES:

Motion was made by JP Malone to approve the minutes of the April 9, 2020 regular meeting, seconded by JP Blackburn. Voice vote, motion carried.

REPORT OF TREASURER:

Motion was made by JP Caldwell to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by JP Evans. Voice vote, motion carried.

Pam Gray, Treasurer, advised when sales tax that was paid in March is reported, it might be a better indication of the affect of the COVID-19 pandemic on the revenue.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2020-COVE CREEK/PEARSON FIRE DUES

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CLEBURNE, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING COVE CREEK/PEARSON FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PLACE FIRE DUES ON PROPERTY TAX STATEMENTS."

WHEREAS, COVE CREEK/PEARSON Fire Department has made a request of the Quorum Court to place the fire department dues on the property tax statements as authorized by A.C.A. §14-20-108;

WHEREAS, COVE CREEK/PEARSON Fire Department submitted with their request a petition filed with the County Clerk and signed by registered voters in the volunteer fire department district as authorized by A.C.A. §14-20-108, as amended by Act 693 of 2015;

WHEREAS, the Cleburne County Clerk has determined that the number of signatures of registered voters in the subject fire district on the petition are sufficient, and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court shall adopt the Ordinance based on the Certification of the Petition by the Cleburne County Clerk under the authority of A.C.A. §14-20-108, as amended by Act 693 of 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ADOPTED:

That as provided by A.C.A. §14-20-108, as amended by Act 693 of 2015, the Cleburne County Tax Collector shall place the fire dues of COVE CREEK/PEARSON Fire Department on the property tax statements. The dues are to be collected by the County and disbursed to the fire department at the discretion of the County Tax Collector, but the Collector shall disburse these paid dues at a minimum of annually. A true and correct copy of this Ordinance shall be published as required by law and effective (30) thirty days following publication.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO 2020-ELECTION COMMISSION COMPENSATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CLEBURNE, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: "AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR CLEBURNE COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSIONERS."

WHEREAS, The Cleburne County Quorum Court finds it necessary to establish the rate of compensation to Cleburne County Election Commissioners for the performance of their duties in service of Cleburne County.

<u>Section 1</u>. The Cleburne County Election Commissioners shall receive as compensation for their services, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per diem when a public meeting is held. A meeting is defined in A.C.A. §7-4-105.

Section 2. For purposes of this Ordinance, in addition to the meaning prescribed in Section 1, "meeting" shall also be defined as when a Cleburne County Election Commissioner, in the course of his/her duties as an Election Commissioner, spends for (4) or more hours in a calendar day dedicated to the performance of duties in his/her official capacity as a Cleburne County Election Commissioner.

<u>Section 3</u>. No Cleburne County Election Commissioner shall receive more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day for services performed in their official capacity as a Cleburne County Election Commissioner.

Section 4. In the event that any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications to this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CLEBURNE, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: "AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2019-020, WHICH ADOPTED THE BUDGET FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2020 AND/OR OTHER PURPOSES TO AMEND THE JUVENILE OFFICER GRANT BUDGET."
