

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CLEBURNE, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: "AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2021-033 ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS AND STARTING SALARIES FOR NON-ELECTED COUNTY POSITIONS TO REVISE THE STARTING SALARY FOR 911 DISPATCHERS".

WHEREAS, there is need to amend Ordinance 2021-033 for the purpose of revising the starting salary of 911 dispatchers.

WHEREAS, there is a need to make this Ordinance retroactive to May 8, 2022, and

WHEREAS, the 2022 salaries for Dispatchers, currently employed at the time of the passage of this Ordinance, will be amended by prorating, according to the retroactive date of this Ordinance, the total increase amount of the starting salary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CLEBURNE COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The following starting salary for 911 Dispatchers shall be amended as follows:

Dispatchers (9) from starting salary of \$25,087.50 to starting salary of \$27,000.00

Section 2. In the event that any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications to this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.


Section 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Emergency Clause

This Ordinance being necessary for the protection and preservation of public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect upon passage and approval of the Cleburne County Judge.
