A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE JUDGE OF CLEBURNE COUNTY, ARKANSAS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SOUTHBUILD

WHEREAS, the Jail Committee has conducted thorough research and due diligence on the need and potential cost for building a new jail;

WHEREAS, the Jail Committee is at the point of needing to proceed with a contract with SouthBuild to be able to go to bid;

WHEREAS, The Jail Committee is seeking the approval of the Cleburne County Quorum Court for the Cleburne County Judge to be authorized to enter into a contract with SouthBuild;

WHEREAS, Entering into a contract with SouthBuild does not obligate Cleburne County to accept the bid but it does obligate the county to certain design/ architectural fees as outlined in the contract. Fees will not exceed the amount of fees for design/ architectural and bidding work that would be associated with a bid of up to 8.1 million dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the Quorum Court of Cleburne County, Arkansas, that the County Judge of Cleburne County is hereby authorized, to sign a contract with SouthBuild for the purpose of entering into a contract with SouthBuild so that they can go to bid.
