

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLEBURNE COUNTY JUDGE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL, DIVISION OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, Cleburne County is applying to the State of Arkansas for an American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grant for a community development project to improve public water supply to areas served by the Wilburn Water Association; and

WHEREAS, the project will provide for a water connection to the Heber Springs water system, replacement of approximately 8.6 miles of leaking water main, replacement of the main booster pump system, and replacement of the telemetry control system; and


WHEREAS, the amount of the proposed grant is estimated to be \$1,400,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that certain conditions as part of the application requirements;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Quorum Court of Cleburne County, Arkansas, hereby declares that the County Judge is authorized to submit an application to the State of Arkansas on behalf of the Wilburn Water Association, to expend funds for the community development project, if the grant is awarded.
