A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE JUDGE OF CLEBURNE COUNTY, ARKANSAS TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE ARKANSAS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FOR A CORONAVIRUS RELATED PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Cleburne County is applying to the State of Arkansas for a Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus project through the Arkansas Economic Development Commission (AEDC). The grant will be used for the purchase of medical equipment for Baptist Health Medical Center-Heber Springs; and
